LOS ANGELES (June 29, 2010) -- On the evening of July 22nd, architect Lauren Rottet's Rottet Studio Los Angeles (555 S. Flower St., 7th floor) will be the nexus of actors, artists and architects with the opening of an art-and-architecture exhibition presented by Barbara Davis Gallery, and the presentation of a Mayoral Commendation by The Honorable Jan Perry, Los Angeles City Councilmember, to The Creative Coalition's Co-Presidents Tim Daly and Dana Delany, CEO Robin Bronk and Chairman Michael Frankfurt.

The exhibition, ELEVATED, is open during business hours and runs from July 22nd through September 6th, and includes contemporary works by Andrea Bianconi, Chuck Close, Paul Fleming, Jenny Holzer, Donald Lipski, Joe Mancuso, Mie Olise, Danny Rolph, Ed Ruscha and Todd Williamson. The exhibition is curated by Barbara Davis.

The architectural drawings section of the exhibit includes work by Norman Foster, OM, FRIBA, FCSD, RDI; Jon Jerde, FAIA; Thom Mayne, FAIA; Richard Meier, FAIA, FRIBA; Mark Rios, FAIA, FASLA and Lauren Rottet, FAIA, IIDA.

"With the interplay of celebrities as contemporary art subjects and advocates for the arts and education, this exhibition and event came together to celebrate the substantive and creative side of contemporary culture," said architect Lauren Rottet, principal of Rottet Studio.
